MR. JOHN F. CROWLEY Executive Chairman of Amicus Therapeutics



John F. Crowley is our Executive Chairman. He served as Chief Executive Officer of Amicus from 2005 to 2022. John's involvement with biotechnology stems from the 1998 diagnosis of two of his children with Pompe disease—a severe and often fatal neuromuscular disorder. In his drive to find a cure for them, he left his position at Bristol-Myers Squibb and became an entrepreneur as the Co-founder, President and CEO of Novazyme Pharmaceuticals, a biotech start-up conducting research on a new experimental treatment for Pompe disease (which he credits as ultimately saving his children's lives).

In 2001, Novazyme was acquired by Genzyme Corporation and John continued to play a lead role in the development of a drug for Pompe disease as Senior Vice President, Genzyme Therapeutics.

John and his family have been profiled numerous times on the front page of The Wall Street Journal and are the subjects of a book by Pulitzer prize-winning journalist Geeta Anand, "The Cure: How a Father Raised \$100 Million-And Bucked the Medical Establishment-In a Quest to Save His Children." The major motion picture, Extraordinary Measures, starring Brendan Fraser and Harrison Ford, is inspired by the Crowley family journey. John is the author of a personal memoir: Chasing Miracles: The Crowley Family Journey of Strength, Hope, and Joy.

John served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Navy Reserve from 2005-2016, assigned to the United States Special Operations Command, and is a veteran of the global war on terrorism, with service in Afghanistan. He graduated with a B.S. in Foreign Service from Georgetown University, and earned a J.D. from the University of Notre Dame Law School and an M.B.A. from Harvard. The Crowley family was the recipient of the 2011 Family Exemplar Award from the University of Notre Dame. He is also a member of the University Council on Science & Technology at Notre Dame. Currently, John serves as a member of the Board of Directors of Intellia Therapeutics, Inc. and Entrada Therapeutics, Inc. He is the former National Chairman of the Make-A-Wish Foundation of America and is a founding Board member of the Global Genes Project. John is a Henry Crown Fellow at the Aspen Institute. He was awarded a Doctor of Laws Degree (Honoris Causa) from the University of Notre Dame, where he delivered the commencement address to the Class of 2020.

MINISTER NORMA FOLEY Minister for Education and TD for County Kerry



Norma Foley TD was appointed Minister for Education in June 2020. The Department has policy responsibility for early years, primary and post-primary education in Ireland. Minister Foley has led the Department of Education during the pandemic, with a strong focus on ensuring ongoing dialogue and engagement with all education stakeholders. Following closure due to COVID-19 in March 2020, she has overseen the reopening of schools in Autumn 2020, putting in place a multi-million euro package of support measures for school communities. She has overseen the successful

development and delivery of alternative assessment mechanisms to facilitate students leaving post-primary schools to progress to further and higher education and the world of work, when traditional examinations were not possible due to COVID-19.

Minister Foley has a passionate interest in excellence and equity in education, most notably when she provided for the inclusion of the student voice as a partner in education. Amongst the key initiatives progressed during her first two and a half years in office Minister Foley has announced the biggest ever expansion of the Delivering Equality of Opportunity In Schools (DEIS) programme ensuring that one out of every four of our students can now avail of DEIS supports. Minister Foley has also undertaken the first comprehensive reform of the Leaving Certificate Programme since the foundation of the State and has recently unveiled Cineáltas, the Department's new Action Plan on Bullying.

Prior to her election to Dáil Eireann and appointment as Minister, Ms Foley worked as a post-primary teacher in her home town of Tralee. A graduate of University College Cork, she served as a member of Kerry County Council for many years and has held the position of Mayor of Tralee on two occasions and also has served as Mayor of County Kerry and served three terms as Mayor of Tralee.





MEDAL OF THE SOCIETY OF THE FRIENDLY SONS OF SAINT PATRICK

On the right Hibernia — on the left America — in the center Liberty joining the hands of Hibernia and America, represented by the usual figures of a female supported by a Harp for Hibernia — an Indian with his quiver on his back, and his bow slung, for America — underneath Unite. On the reverse, St. Patrick trampling on a snake — a cross in his hand—dressed in Pontificahbus, — the motto "Hier."

These devices, designed some years before the Revolution, were certainly ominous, if not prophetic, — The Goddess of Liberty" joining the hands of Hibernia and America, with the superscription, "Unite," was sufficiently significant, considering that the effect of that union powerfully promoted the subsequent dismemberment of the British Empire, and the establishment of the liberty and independence of America. The motto Hier, or, without the aspirate, Iar, In the Celtic Language, signifies "West," — and from it came the name of the country Ere, Erin, or Ireland; and Ierna, aspirated Hibernia. But the word "Hier" had in it a duplicate and equivocal signification; peculiarly appropriate as the motto of a society whose object was to "Unite," in fellowship, the sons of the little Isle of the "West," with those of the great continent of the "West."
