Dr. John Teeling is one of Ireland's leading entrepreneurs. John Teeling was sponsored by the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick to study at and attain his MBA at the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School of Business, after which he went on to earn a doctorate in business at Harvard University.

Throughout a long business career in Ireland, John has been involved in a wide spectrum of

business ranging from textiles to exploration. John Teeling has also led the renaissance in Irish Whiskey. In 1987, Mr. Teeling established the first new Irish distillery in over 100 years in Cooley, Ireland (Co. Louth) and subsequently re-opened the Lockes Distillery (Kilbeggan, Co. Westmeath). The group was later sold to Jim Beam in 2011. John went on to establish the Great Northern Distillery on the former Harp Brewery site, which operates both single malt and grain distilleries on one site in Dundalk, Ireland (Co. Louth). It is now the second largest distilling company in Ireland.

As an investor in mining and oil since 1983, he has founded a number of Stock Exchange listed explorers. He currently chairs four, having sold three in recent years. He explores for diamonds, gold, oil and zinc in Africa, Ireland and the Middle East.

John, who lectured in Business Administration at University College Dublin for 20 years, also holds degrees with his alma mater, University College Dublin (B. Comm, M. Econ Sc.).

Since founding the firm in 2006, the organization has secured about \$30 billion in fund equity commitments, representing pension, sovereign wealth, endowment, insurance, and foundation partners from around the globe. EQT Exeter's funds have made over 1,800 real estate investments, corresponding to over 2,500 properties in the warehouse/logistics, office/life science and

multifamily sectors, totaling more than \$30 billion in property value.

Prior to Exeter, Ward was part of the senior management team at Rouse/Liberty Property Trust, a \$7 billion publicly traded office and industrial REIT, which he helped take public in 1994. In addition to his business endeavors, Ward sits on the Board of Trustees for The Papal Foundation, The National Centre for Padre Pio, and Catholic Leadership Institute. He also sits on the Business Advisory Council and is the chairman of the Institute of Real Estate at the University of Notre Dame. He serves on the Advisory Council at Jefferson University Hospital Neurology Institute and its Raphael Center for Neurorestoration, and supports Project Home and its Inn of Amazing Mercy.

Ward holds an MBA from Harvard Business School ('89) and a BA in Business Administration from the University of Notre Dame ('85).

The Society of the Friendly Sons & Daughters of Saint Patrick-Scholarship Endowments - 2024

In 2016 the Society engaged in a program of establishing scholarship endowments to students in need and where appropriate a priority given to students traveling to Ireland.

Starting with a \$70,000 scholarship endowment at St. Josephs University the society now has fully funded 19 scholarship endowments with a market value of \$2,174,000 Dollars and generating various available scholarship grants totaling approximately \$75,000 per year.

MEDAL OF THE SOCIETY OF THE FRIENDLY SONS OF SAINT PATRICK

On the right Hibernia — on the left America — in the center Liberty joining the hands of Hibernia and America, represented by the usual figures of a female supported by a Harp for Hibernia — an Indian with his guiver on his back, and his bow slung, for America — underneath Unite. On the reverse, St. Patrick trampling on a snake — a cross in his hand dressed in Pontificahbus, — the motto "Hier."

These devices, designed some years before the Revolution, were certainly ominous, if not prophetic, — The Goddess of Liberty" joining the hands of Hibernia and America, with the superscription, "Unite," was sufficiently significant, considering that the effect of that union powerfully promoted the subsequent dismemberment of the British Empire, and the establishment of the liberty and independence of America. The motto Hier, or, without the aspirate, Iar, In the Celtic Language, signifies "West," — and from it came the name of the country Ere, Erin, or Ireland; and lerna, aspirated Hibernia. But the word "Hier" had in it a duplicate and equivocal signification; peculiarly appropriate as the motto of a society whose object was to "Unite," in fellowship, the sons of the little Isle of the "West," with those of the great continent of the "West."
